### CHANGING THE SHORTCUT ICON TO FIREPRO



#### Changing the FirePro2 Shortcut **Icon**.

This may be slightly different for different operating systems. These instructions are for Windows XP, which most of you are using. If you do not have a shortcut already, go to your FirePro2 folder, right click on the "FirePro2.lbs" file, and then click on "Create Shortcut". This will add a shortcut to FirePro2 to your computer's desktop.

1. Go to your computer desktop and right click on your FirePro2 shortcut. Click "Properties", then click the "ShortCut" tab.
2. Click on the "Change Icon" button.
3. Click on the "Browse" button.
4. Find your FirePro folder (the default location for this is C:\firepro but this may be different on your computer).
5. Select the file called "firepro2.ico" and click "Open". (Not all users will have this file. If you don't, please let us know and we will send it to you). If you want to use a different icon, you may do that as well.
6. Click "OK", and "OK" again.

If you have more than one computer running FirePro you will have to do this on each computer that you want the icon to show on.
